


### **REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS FOR:**

Flame Sensor, Flame Rollout Switch, Ignitor Electrode



Accessing these components can require some preparation due to the limited space... See inside for tips to aid in removing these parts.

### Getting Started...

- 1. AGAIN, BEFORE STARTING... PLEASE MAKE SURE THE POWER HAS BEEN TURNED OFF TO THE UNIT!
- 2. Remove the entire top front panel to give yourself plenty of working room.



3. Remove the control board by removing 5/16" screws. Carefully swing the board away from the work area.

Note: If your unit has the control board mounted on fire wall, you will not have to remove the board.

4. Remove the pressure switch by removing two 1/4" screws located behind the "L" bracket.



Carefully swing away the pressure switch from the work area.



### Flame Sensor, Rollout Switch, Ignitor Electrode - Replacement

**5.** Disconnect the orange tubing connected to the ventor assembly.



Orange tubing shown disconnected from the ventor assembly.


Now you will have the room to access the components.



You will need 1/4" wrenches to remove the components.




## 1. Locate the proper components.





# Removing the flame sensor...

1. Reach your arm around the right side of the burner and remove (1) 1/4" screw.



2. After screw has been removed, reach around the left side of the burner to remove the flame sensor.





## Removing the flame rollout switch...

1. There are (2) screws.


Reach your arm around the right side of the burner and remove the back 1/4" screw.



2. From the left side of the burner, access and remove the front 1/4" screw.




- 3. Remove the rollout switch from the left side of the burner.
- 4. Reverse the process to install the new flame rollout switch.



# Removing the ignitor electrode...

- 1. Reach (1) 1/4" screw from the front of the burner box.
- 2. Remove the ignitor electrode from the front of the burner box.



3. Reverse the process to install the new ignitor electrode.
